OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

Objective

- To provide an attractive rate of return.

Main Investments

- At least 70% of the Fund's investments will be in Fixed Income Securities (e.g. bonds).

Investment Policy

- To invest in lower rated bonds issued by governments, agencies and corporations operating in both developed and emerging markets. These bonds usually offer a higher yield than higher rated bonds. Lower rated bonds are defined as being rated lower than BBB- by S&P or Fitch; or lower than Baa3 by Moody's.
- As an essential and integrated part of the research process and through engagement with issuers, the Investment Adviser incorporates an assessment of sustainability related risks and opportunities into the assessment process.
- The Fund includes climate- and weapons related exclusions; and other sector/industry restrictions, including tobacco. For further details, please see the Fund's prospectus on the UCITS website (www.morganstanleyinvestmentfunds.com and on www.msim.com).
- The Fund will measure its performance against the ICE BofA Developed Markets High Yield Excluding Subordinated Financial Index USD-Hedged (the "Benchmark"). The Fund is actively managed and is not designed to track the Benchmark. Therefore, the management of the Fund is not constrained by the composition of the Benchmark.

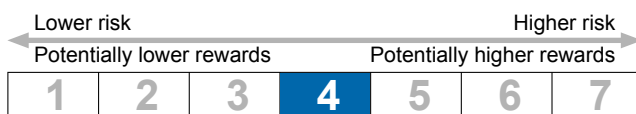
Other Information

- The Fund may invest up to 30% of its assets in other fixed income securities that do not meet the above criteria, for example higher quality bonds.
- The Fund may invest in derivatives, financial instruments which take their value indirectly from other assets, for investment or efficient portfolio management purposes. They rely on other companies to fulfil contractual obligations and carry more risk. Refer to the prospectus ('Financial Derivative Instruments' section) for more details.
- The Fund may invest up to 10% of its assets in securities acquired on the China Interbank Bond Market.
- This is a currency hedged share class. It aims to reduce the impact on your investment of movements in the exchange rate between the fund currency and the share class currency.
- Income may be paid quarterly in cash or additional shares.

Buying and selling shares

- Investors may buy and sell shares on every full banking business day in Luxembourg.

RISK AND REWARD PROFILE

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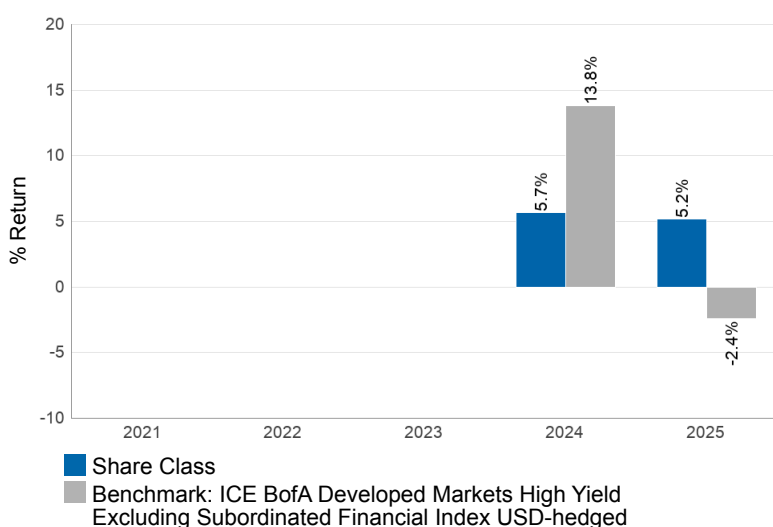
The entry and exit charges shown are maximum figures. In some cases you might pay less, you can find this out from your financial adviser.

Therefore, the Fund's performance between 1 April 2022 and 19 October 2023 was achieved under different circumstances. Past performance is based on the performance of Eaton Vance International (Ireland) Sustainable Global High Yield Bond Fund that was absorbed into this Fund on 18 November 2022.
